Thank you for your request of 11th July 2017. You requested the following information:

"I am in process of writing business case for developing software and hardware (Safety Critical) for Re-control on Relay Based interlocking (RRI) with in UK. I kindly request to provide me an comprehensive list of interlocking's which are relay based interlocking. The list should also contain - Station / Area name, Type of RRI interlocking (BR-Free wired , E10k , GEC - Geographical ...) and also possible type of Control Systems.

This information will be used as an business case study inorder for our R&D Team to invest time and money to develop Software and Hardware to recontrol Relay Based interlocking."

I have processed your request under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). I can confirm that we hold the information you requested.

Please find enclosed an Excel spreadsheet called 'SSADS relay areas 2017-07-11' which contains the information mentioned in your request.

One point worth noting is that this document was produced to assist the business with planning interventions and contains future dates which are indicative of relative remaining life. These dates are not planned dates for renewal, which may occur before or after these dates which are primarily used to help the business prioritise planning interventions in conjunction with engineering judgement.
