#### Information request Reference number: FOI2018/00531

Thank you for your email of 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2018, in which you requested the following information:

I would like to make a FOI request into how Network Rail handles its own internal grievance process and related matters.

I would be grateful if the following information could be provided:

- 1. What number of raised grievances actually have the initial interview arranged within Network Rail's standard of 7 days and how does that equate to percentage of all grievances raised
- What number of internal grievances progress through to the employment tribunal and how does that equate to percentage of all grievances raised
- 3. What number of raised grievances concern disability discrimination and how does that equate to percentage of all grievances raised
- 4. What number of internal grievances that concern disability discrimination progress through to the employment tribunal and how does that equate to percentage of all grievances raised

I have processed your request under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

I can confirm that we hold some of the information you requested. To summarise, we do not hold the information requested in your first question and for questions two to four we only hold information going back two years.

# 1. What number of raised grievances actually have the initial interview arranged within Network Rail's standard of 7 days and how does that equate to percentage of all grievances raised

We do not hold the information requested for this part of your request as we do not record information at this level of detail.

We have been advised that we capture the date the grievance was received and the date of the hearing, but not the date that those hearing arrangements are made.

If you would like the information we do capture then please do contact us to let us know. However, we need to caveat that the hearing date is the date the hearing takes place and so does not factor in those occasions when hearings are postponed due to lack of availability, sickness, etc.

### 2. What number of internal grievances progress through to the employment tribunal and how does that equate to percentage of all grievances raised

In the last two years there have been 1,621 Grievances, of these, 36 progressed to Employment Tribunal. This equates to 2.22% when expressed as a percentage of all grievances raised.

### 3. What number of raised grievances concern disability discrimination and how does that equate to percentage of all grievances raised

26 Grievances related to disability discrimination, this is 1.60% of all grievances raised.

# 4. What number of internal grievances that concern disability discrimination progress through to the employment tribunal and how does that equate to percentage of all grievances raised.

In the last two years, 6 disability discrimination grievances progressed to Employment Tribunal, this is 0.37% of all grievances raised.
