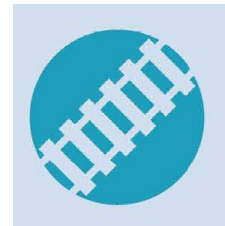


## King's Lynn Service Enhancement Scheme

Network Rail has completed infrastructure works funded by the Department for Transport to allow Great Northern to run longer trains, calling at all stations between Cambridge and King's Lynn from 13 December 2020. Longer trains will double the space and seats on Great Northern services for Fen Line passengers and ease overcrowding, giving a better, overall travelling experience.

A new siding has been constructed just outside of the station to provide the operational flexibility to park and store a longer train to be ready for the first and last train of the day.

We've extended platform 2 to accommodate longer trains and installed lighting, seats and a shelter. New stairs and a ramp providing step-free access to Platform 1 has been provided and the vehicle underpass has been changed to provide a safe route under the railway for pedestrians.



Waterbeach station benefits from extensions to both platforms to accommodate the longer trains. Platform lighting, seating and a shelter has been provided for the benefit of passengers.
